**BISHOP'S CERTIFICATE IN CATECHESIS. Adult Formation Department will be commencing a new BCC course at Holy Trinity Parish Centre in Newark beginning February 4th 2017.**

The course aims to cover: the essential fundamentals of the faith; basics skills for catechists and also nurtures spiritual formation. This is a twenty-four-hour course divided into twelve sessions followed by a commissioning service. It costs £100 per person and parishes are encouraged to fund the course for their own catechists. If you have any catechists who have missed sessions this is a good opportunity to catch up and receive the certificate from Bishop Patrick.
