RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR CHILDREN - RCIC

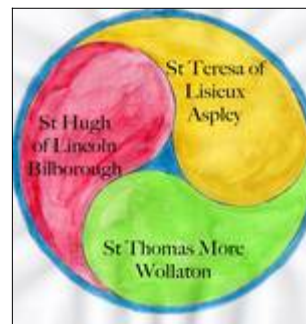
